PLEASE RESPOND IMMEDIATELY

Under Section 121.54(2), Wisconsin Statutes, the Glendale-River Hills School District, just like every other public school district in the State of Wisconsin, is required to provide transportation to students who meet certain eligibility requirements. As a result, bus routes are created using a list of all eligible students in the District to ensure this requirement is met. However, there are a large number of students who do not ride the bus each year for various reasons leading to some routes operating below capacity. In order to improve efficiencies in the District, we are looking for information from families on their intent to ride for the upcoming school year.

Please note that indicating “no” in the section below will not prevent you from obtaining transportation at any point in the year. As stated above, the District is required to provide transportation to any student who is eligible and this process is only intended to streamline routes for families that know they will not be using district provided transportation. 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# YOUTH SOFTBALL LEAGUE
