

In January in the Library, we are focusing on award winning books. Currently we are taking a look at the five books that have been nominated for the Wisconsin Golden Archer Award. The Golden Archer Award began in 1974 and is Wisconsin's student choice book award. Students across the state can cast their vote for their favorite. The awards are given in four age level categories - Primary, Intermediate, Middle and High.



At Parkway we will enjoy each of the five nominees in the Primary Category and then vote for our favorite. Students are excited to know that they get to help decide which of the five books will get to wear the Golden Archer award sticker!

During Library Media students will have a choice of activities that corresponds with these books: word search, puzzles, directed drawing, and PebbleGo research. If your student brings home a drawing or worksheet for one of the books, ask them to tell you about the story. What did they like about the book? Is it their favorite so far? 




